| EVALUATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS

|  
| The evaluation of the instructional program shall be a major responsibility of the  
| Superintendent and his/her staff with periodic reports being presented to the Board to enable  
| judgments to be made on the success of the program. No instructional program should be  
| considered the final answer. It should be borne in mind that instruction is the primary  
| responsibility of the school, and all other activities are merely subsidiary. This being the  
| case, the evaluation of the instructional program shall be done with great care and the Board  
| kept informed at all times.

| Moreover, the Superintendent is expected to lead the staff, community and Board in the  
| development and on-going review of Board-adopted criteria and standards by which to measure  
| the results of the instructional program.
